

## WHAT WILL IT COST?

The journey will be charged like a bus fare.

Concessionary passes will be valid on all journeys, in accordance with standard terms of validity.

You will be advised of the fare when you book your journey and a ticket will be issued when you board.

## WHERE & WHEN CAN I GO?

The map inside shows the area served. The service is available from 0700 to 1900, Monday to Saturday.

The bus will take you to any of the towns or villages within the service area shown on the map.

Connections can be made for onwards travel to places further afield such as Ipswich.

## WHO RUNS THE SERVICE?

The service is operated by CATS (Coastal Accessible Transport Scheme).

## IS THE VEHICLE ACCESSIBLE?

The vehicle is fully accessible with low steps, hand rails and a lift for wheelchair access. Let us know when you book if you require assistance.

## WHAT IS IT?

Suffolk Links is a Demand Responsive Transport (DRT) service which provides connections to bus and train links in rural areas.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you wish to travel in the area covered by Suffolk Links Wilford and are not able to access a bus service directly, the service will pick you up from a convenient point.

Where appropriate the service will connect with bus services for onward travel to further destinations.

For journeys within the service area where connecting to other services is inappropriate, end to end journeys will be possible.

Simply call **0845 604 1802** up to a week before you wish to travel and book your journey.

Suffolk Links Wilford will then pick you up at the point agreed and take you where you want to go within the defined area.

The booking service is open from 0800 to 1800 Monday to Friday, making it easier for you to plan ahead.

Bookings will be on a first come, first served basis.

## OTHER SERVICES IN THE AREA

Suffolk Links Wilford serves an area that covers Bawdsey, Hollesley, Orford, Rendlesham, Sutton, Woodbridge and villages in between. The service also connects with Suffolk Links Aide to the north and west.

### Buses:

Suffolk Links Wilford can provide connections with the bus services detailed below, or take you direct when no buses are available, just ask the operator when you ring **0845 604 1802**.

Other buses include:

- 63:** Every two hours between Framlingham, Woodbridge and Ipswich.
- 64:** Every hour between Aldeburgh, Leiston, Saxmundham, Woodbridge and Ipswich.
- 65:** Every two hours between Rendlesham, Woodbridge and Ipswich.
- 165:** Every hour between Aldeburgh, Rendlesham, Woodbridge and Ipswich.

### Trains:

In addition trains run from the stations at Woodbridge and Melton every two hours to Lowestoft, and hourly to Saxmundham and Ipswich.

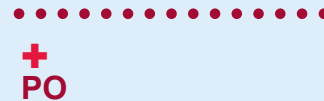

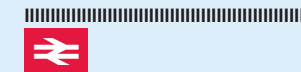
