

WHAT WILL IT COST?

The journey will be charged like a bus fare.

Concessionary passes will be valid on all journeys, in accordance with standard terms of validity.

You will be advised of the fare when you book your journey and a ticket will be issued when you board.

WHERE & WHEN CAN I GO?

The map inside shows the area served. The service is available from 0700 to 1900, Monday to Saturday.

The bus will take you to Saxmundham, Leiston or the railway station at Darsham, or any of the villages within the area shown on the map.

Connections can be made for onwards travel to places further afield such as Halesworth, Lowestoft, Woodbridge or Ipswich.

WHO RUNS THE SERVICE?

The service is operated by Coastal Accessible Transport Services.

IS THE VEHICLE ACCESSIBLE?

The vehicle is fully accessible with low steps, hand rails and a lift for wheelchair access. Let us know when you book if you require assistance.

WHAT IS IT?

Suffolk Links is a Demand Responsive Transport (DRT) service which provides connections to bus and train links in rural areas.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you wish to travel in the area covered by Suffolk Links Blyth and are not able to access a bus service directly, the service will pick you up from a convenient point.

Where appropriate the service will connect with bus services for onward travel to further destinations.

For journeys within the service area where connecting to other services is inappropriate, end to end journeys will be possible.

Simply call **01728 833 526** up to a week before you wish to travel and book your journey.

Suffolk Links Blyth will then pick you up at the point agreed and take you where you want to go within the defined area.

The booking service is open from 0800 to 1800 Monday to Friday, making it easier for you to plan ahead.

Bookings will be on a first come, first served basis.

OTHER SERVICES IN THE AREA

Suffolk Links Blyth serves the area between Suffolk Links Alde to the south, Suffolk Links Loes to the west and Suffolk Links Pathfinder towards Halesworth.

The area served covers Blythburgh, Walberswick, Dunwich, Minsmere, Yoxford, Saxmundham, Leiston and many other villages inbetween.

Buses:

Suffolk Links Blyth can provide connections with the bus services detailed below, or take you direct when no buses are available, just ask the operator when you ring **01728 833 526**.

Other buses include:

64 Hourly between Aldeburgh, Leiston, Saxmundham, Wickham Market, Woodbridge and Ipswich.

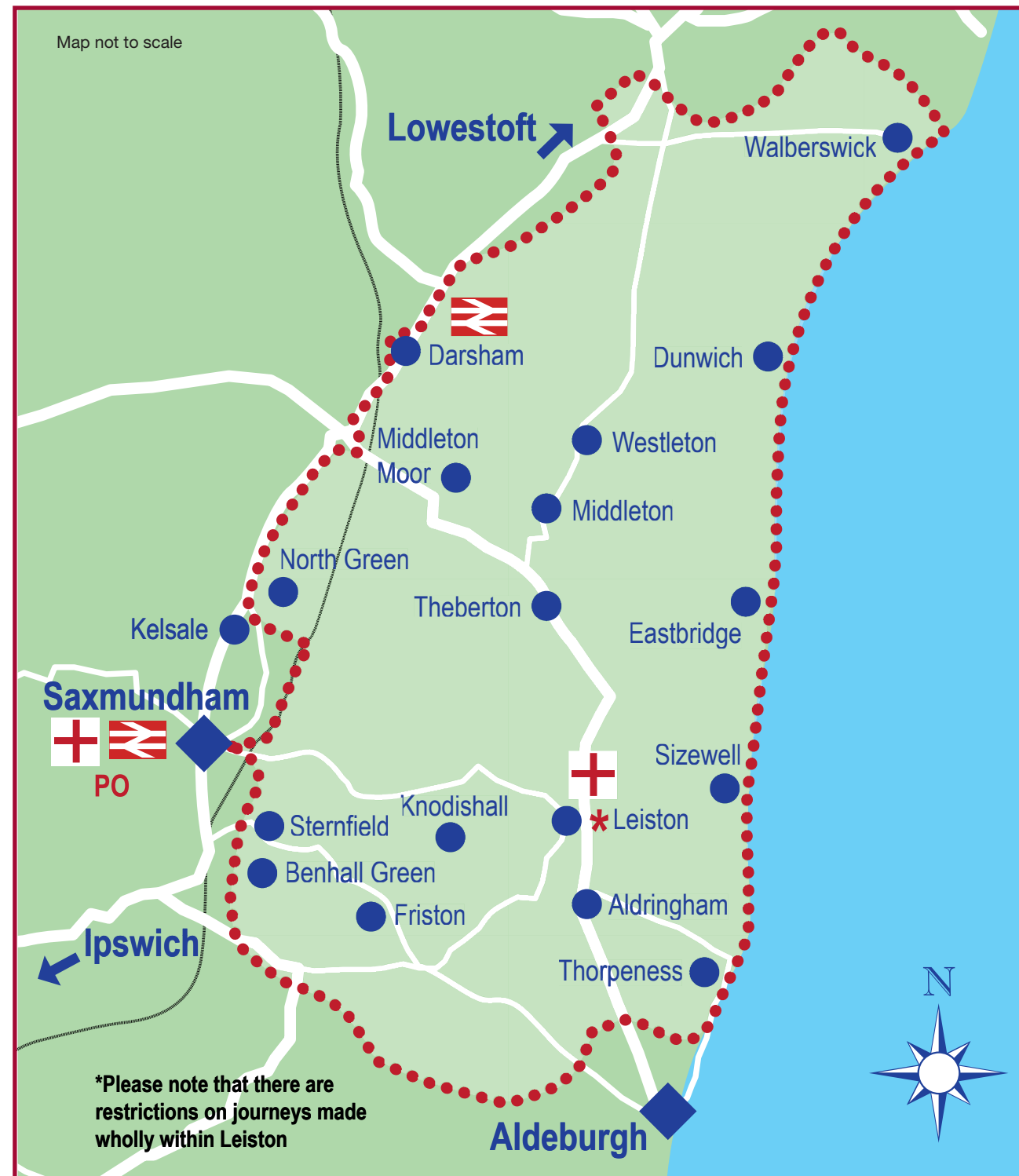
165 Hourly between Aldeburgh, Snape, Rendlesham, Woodbridge and Ipswich.

196: Once a day between Leiston, Yoxford, Peasenhall and Saxmundham.

521 Five journeys per day between Aldeburgh, Thorpeness, Leiston, Friston, Saxmundham and Halesworth.

Trains:

In addition, trains run from the station at Darsham every two hours to Lowestoft or Ipswich. Trains also run every hour between Saxmundham and Ipswich.
