

## WHAT WILL IT COST?

The journey will be charged like a bus fare.

Concessionary passes will be valid on all journeys, in accordance with standard terms of validity.

You will be advised of the fare when you book your journey and a ticket will be issued when you board.

## WHERE & WHEN CAN I GO?

The map inside shows the area served. The service is available from 0700 to 1900, Monday to Saturday.

The bus will take you to Framlingham, Saxmundham or the railway station at Darsham, or any of the villages within the area shown on the map.

Connections can be made for onwards travel to places further afield such as Ipswich, Diss, Woodbridge or Lowestoft.

## WHO RUNS THE SERVICE?

The service is operated by WRVS.

## IS THE VEHICLE ACCESSIBLE?

The vehicle is fully accessible with low steps, hand rails and a lift for wheelchair access. Let us know when you book if you require assistance.

# DEMAND RESPONSIVE TRANSPORT LOES LINKING SUFFOLK TO YOU

## WHAT IS IT?

Suffolk Links is a Demand Responsive Transport (DRT) service which provides connections to bus and train links in rural areas.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you wish to travel in the area covered by Suffolk Links Loes and are not able to access a bus service directly, the service will pick you up from a convenient point.

Where appropriate the service will connect with bus services for onward travel to further destinations.

For journeys within the service area where connecting to other services is inappropriate, end to end journeys will be possible.

Simply call **01473 744 619** up to a week before you wish to travel and book your journey.

Suffolk Links Loes will then pick you up at the point agreed and take you where you want to go within the defined area.

The booking service is open from 0930 to 1330 Monday to Friday, making it easier for you to plan ahead.

Bookings will be on a first come, first served basis.

## OTHER SERVICES IN THE AREA

Suffolk Links Loes serves the area between Suffolk Links Blyth to the east, Suffolk Links Alde to the south and Suffolk Links Pathfinder to the north. The area served covers Yoxford, Badingham, Earl Soham, Parham, Great Glemham and Rendham.

### Buses:

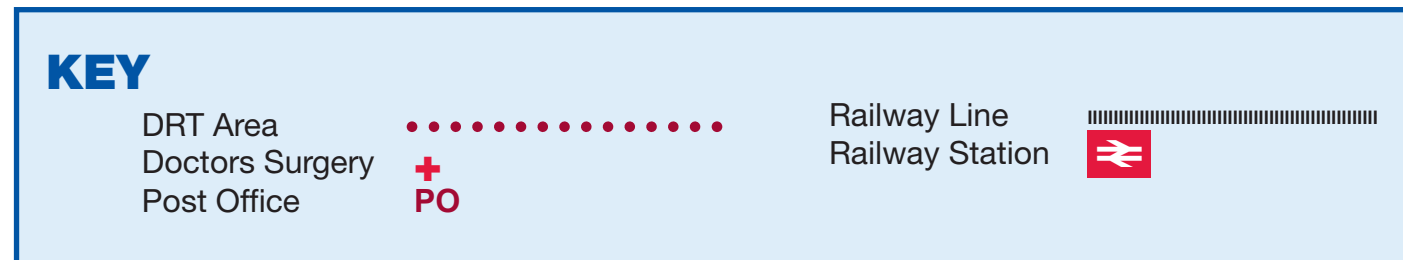
Suffolk Links Loes can provide connections with the bus services detailed below, or take you direct when no buses are available, just ask the operator when you ring **01473 744 619**.

Other buses are:

- 63** Every two hours between Framlingham, Wickham Market, Woodbridge and Ipswich.
- 64** Hourly between Aldeburgh, Leiston, Saxmundham, Wickham Market, Woodbridge and Ipswich.
- 118, 119** Every hour from Framlingham to Ipswich via Earl Soham or Otley.
- 196** Operates between Leiston, Yoxford, Peasenhall & Saxmundham.
- 482** Three times a day from Framlingham to Diss via Badingham & Laxfield.
- 521** Five journeys per day between Aldeburgh, Thorpeness, Leiston, Friston, Saxmundham and Halesworth.

### Trains:

Trains run from the station at Darsham every two hours to Lowestoft or Ipswich, and every hour between Saxmundham and Ipswich.
