

WHAT WILL IT COST?

The journey will be charged like a bus fare.

Concessionary passes will be valid on all journeys, in accordance with standard terms of validity.

You will be advised of the fare when you book your journey and a ticket will be issued when you board.

WHERE & WHEN CAN I GO?

The map inside shows the area served. The service is available from 0700 to 1900, Tuesday to Sunday.

The bus will take you to Bungay, Halesworth, Wrentham or the railway station at Darsham, or any of the villages within the area shown on the map.

Connections can be made for onwards travel to places further afield such as Ipswich, Norwich, Southwold or Lowestoft.

WHO RUNS THE SERVICE?

The service is operated by Halesworth Volunteer Centre.

IS THE VEHICLE ACCESSIBLE?

The vehicle is fully accessible with low steps, hand rails and a lift for wheelchair access. Let us know when you book if you require assistance.

WHAT IS IT?

Suffolk Links is a Demand Responsive Transport (DRT) service which provides connections to bus and train links in rural areas.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you wish to travel in the area covered by Suffolk Links Pathfinder and are not able to access a bus service directly, the service will pick you up from a convenient point.

Where appropriate the service will connect with bus services for onward travel to further destinations.

For journeys within the service area where connecting to other services is inappropriate, end to end journeys will be possible.

Simply call **01986 874479** up to a week before you wish to travel and book your journey.

Suffolk Links Pathfinder will then pick you up at the point agreed and take you where you want to go within the defined area.

The booking service is open from 1000 to 1300 Monday to Friday, making it easier for you to plan ahead.

Bookings will be on a first come, first served basis.

OTHER SERVICES IN THE AREA

Suffolk Links Pathfinder serves the area between Suffolk Links Loes to the south and Suffolk Links Blyth to the east. The area served covers Peasenhall, Laxfield, the Saints, the Elmhams, Henstead and Brampton.

Buses:

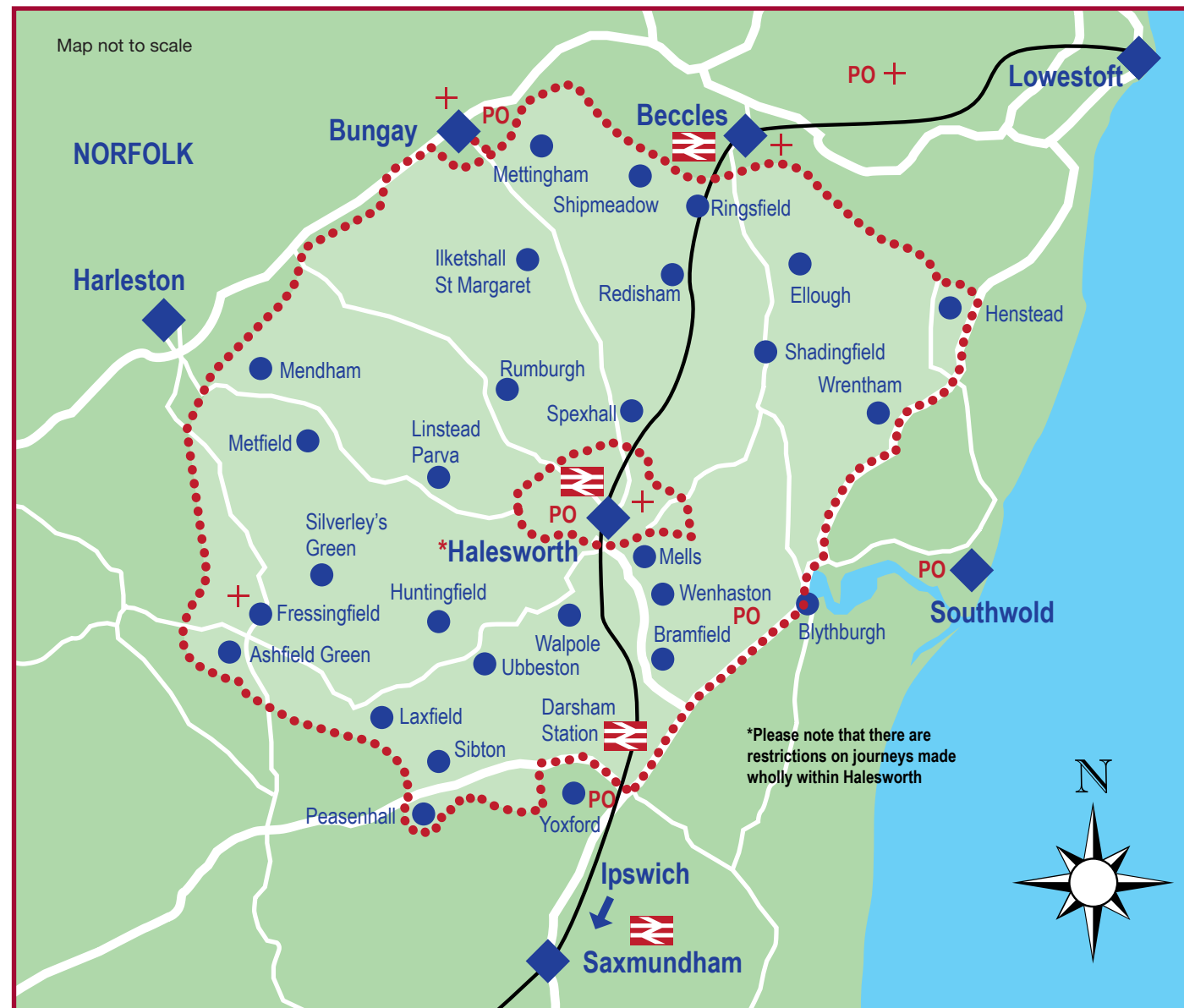
Suffolk Links Pathfinder can provide connections with the bus services detailed below, or take you direct when no buses are available, just ask the operator when you ring **01986 874479**.

Other buses are:

- 520** Every two hours between Halesworth & Southwold.
- 521** Five times a day between Aldeburgh, Saxmundham, Darsham & Halesworth.
- 522** Five times a day between Halesworth & Beccles.
- 523** Four times a day between Beccles & Mutford.
- 524** Every two hours between Beccles & Southwold.
- 580, 581** Every hour between Diss, Bungay, Beccles & Great Yarmouth.
- 588** Every half an hour between Halesworth, Bungay & Norwich.
- 601** Regular services between Great Yarmouth, Lowestoft & Southwold.

Trains:

Trains run from the stations at Darsham and Halesworth every two hours to Lowestoft or Ipswich.
