

## WHAT WILL IT COST?

The journey will be charged like a bus fare.

Concessionary passes will be valid on all journeys, in accordance with standard terms of validity.

You will be advised of the fare when you book your journey and a ticket will be issued when you board.

## WHERE & WHEN CAN I GO?

The map inside shows the area served. The service is available from 0700 to 1900, Monday to Saturday.

The bus will take you to Debenham, Eye, Framlingham or the railway station at Halesworth, or any of the villages within the area shown on the map.

Connections can be made for onwards travel to places further afield such as Ipswich, Lowestoft or Norwich.

## WHO RUNS THE SERVICE?

The service is operated by Halesworth Volunteer Centre.

## IS THE VEHICLE ACCESSIBLE?

The vehicle is fully accessible with low steps, hand rails and a lift for wheelchair access. Let us know when you book if you require assistance.

## WHAT IS IT?

Suffolk Links is a Demand Responsive Transport (DRT) service which provides connections to bus and train links in rural areas.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you wish to travel in the area covered by Suffolk Links Hoxne Area and are not able to access a bus service directly, the service will pick you up from a convenient point.

Where appropriate the service will connect with bus and train services for onward travel to further destinations.

For journeys within the service area where connecting to other services is inappropriate, end to end journeys will be possible.

Simply call **01986 875600** up to a week before you wish to travel and book your journey.

Suffolk Links Hoxne Area will then pick you up at the point agreed and take you where you want to go within the defined area.

The booking service is open from 1000 to 1300 Monday to Friday, making it easier for you to plan ahead.

Bookings will be on a first come, first served basis.

## OTHER SERVICES IN THE AREA

Suffolk Links Hoxne Area borders with other demand responsive services. Suffolk Links Gipping North borders the area to the south west, Borderhoppa to the north, Suffolk Links Pathfinder to the east and Suffolk Links Loes to the south east.

The area served covers Laxfield, Stradbroke, Thorndon, Worlingworth, Dennington, Cretingham and many other villages in the area.

### Buses:

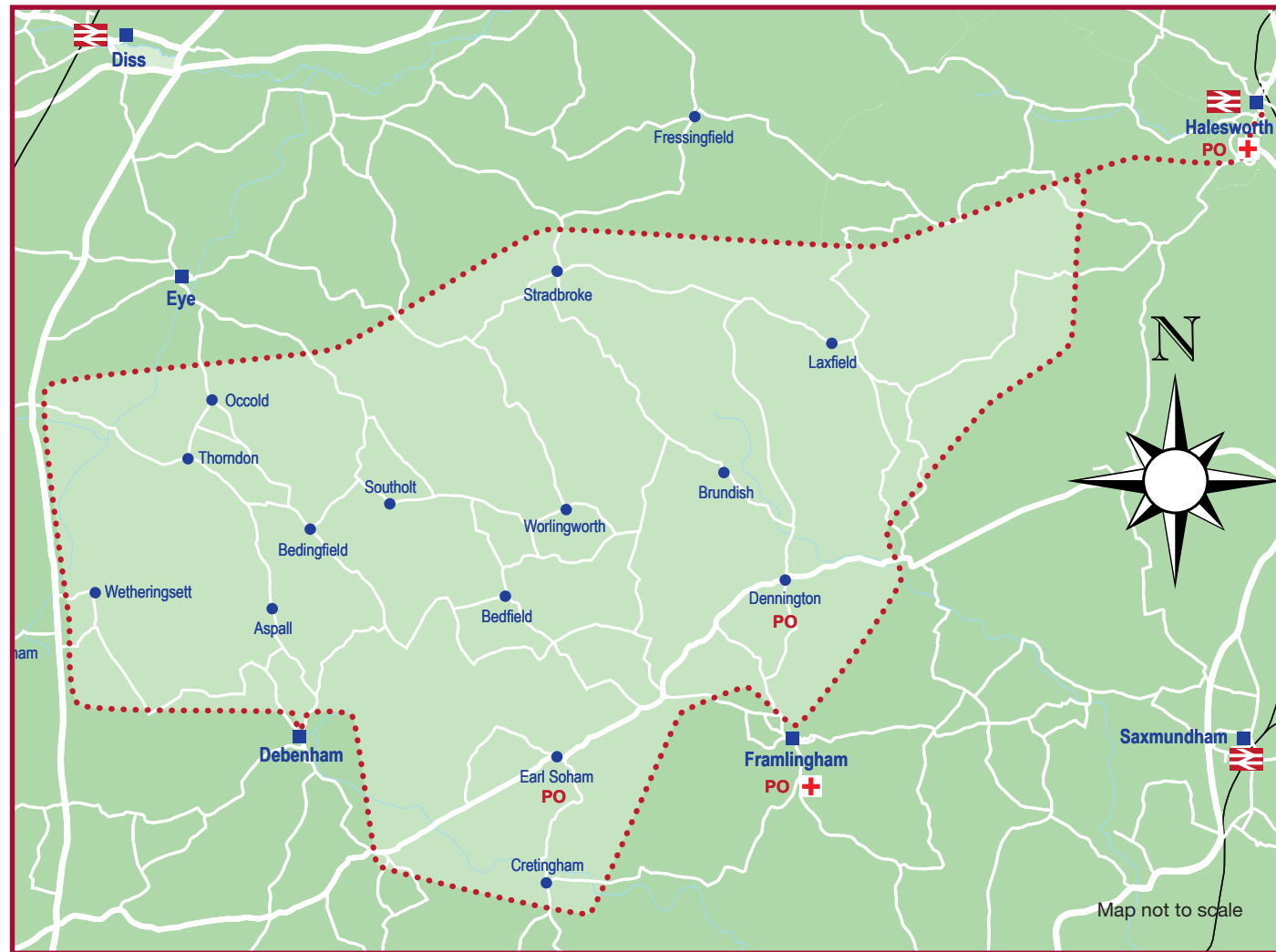
Suffolk Links Hoxne Area can provide connections with the bus services detailed below, or take you direct when no buses are available, just ask the operator when you ring **01986 875600**.

Other main buses include:

- 63:** Every two hours between Framlingham, Woodbridge & Ipswich.
- 113, 114:** Regular services between Diss, Eye & Ipswich.
- 116:** Six times a day between Debenham, Coddham & Ipswich.
- 118, 119:** Hourly services between Framlingham, Westerfield & Ipswich.
- 482:** Three times a day between Framlingham, Stradbroke & Diss.
- 588:** Every half an hour between Halesworth, Bungay & Norwich.

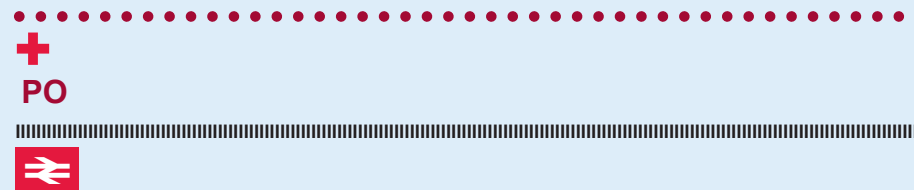
### Trains:
