

WHERE & WHEN CAN I GO?

The map inside shows the area served. Suffolk Links Buzabout will take you to the railway stations at Ipswich or Manningtree, the London Road Park & Ride site at Copdock or any of the villages within the area shown on the map.

Connections can be made for onwards travel to places further afield such as Ipswich town centre, Lowestoft or Norwich.

Evening Services:

Due to a special partnership arrangement, additional evening services are being provided on Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays up until midnight.

This is being supported by a number of Parish Councils in the area, Suffolk ACRE as the operator, and Suffolk County Council.

In the evening, the service will be extended in Ipswich to serve Cardinal Park, Princes Street and the Old Cattle Market Bus Station. Special fares apply after 1900.

WHAT IS IT?

Suffolk Links is a Demand Responsive Transport (DRT) service which provides connections to bus and train links in rural areas.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

If you wish to travel in the area covered by Suffolk Links Buzabout and are not able to access a bus service directly, the service will pick you up from a convenient point.

Where appropriate the service will connect with bus and train services for onward travel to further destinations.

For journeys within the service area where connecting to other services is inappropriate, end to end journeys will be possible.

Simply call **0845 458 1920** up to a week before you wish to travel and book your journey.

Suffolk Links Buzabout will then pick you up at the point agreed and take you where you want to go within the defined area.

The booking service is open from 0900 to 1600 Monday to Friday, making it easier for you to plan ahead.

Bookings will be on a first come, first served basis.

RING, RESERVE & RIDE

OTHER SERVICES IN THE AREA

Suffolk Links Buzabout can connect you with other demand responsive services. Suffolk Links Brett borders the area to the west and Ipswich Dial-A-Ride is to the north.

The area served covers Capel St Mary, Copdock, Belstead, Stratford St Mary, East Bergholt, Brantham, Cattawade, Bentley, Tattingstone, Freston, Stutton, Holbrook, Harkstead, Erwarton, Woolverstone, Chelmondiston, Shotley and Shotley Gate.

Buses:

Suffolk Links Buzabout can provide connections with the bus services detailed below, or take you direct when no buses are available, just ask the operator when you ring **0845 458 1920**.

Other main buses include:

92: Every two hours between Ipswich, Holbrook & Cattawade.

93: Every two hours between Ipswich, Capel St Mary, East Bergholt & Colchester.

94: Four times a day between Hadleigh, East Bergholt & Colchester.

96, 96A: Every two hours between Ipswich, Tattingstone, Capel St Mary, East Bergholt, Cattawade & Mistley.

98: Every two hours between Ipswich, Holbrook & Shotley Gate.

202: Every two hours between Ipswich, Chelmondiston & Shotley Gate.

WHO RUNS THE SERVICE?

The service is operated by Suffolk ACRE (Action with Communities in Rural England).

IS THE VEHICLE ACCESSIBLE?

The vehicle is fully accessible with low steps, hand rails and a lift for wheelchair access. Let us know when you book if you require assistance.

OTHER SERVICES IN THE AREA

Trains:

Mainline trains run from Ipswich and Manningtree to London or Norwich. There are additional branch line trains from Manningtree to Harwich and from Ipswich to Felixstowe, Lowestoft, Cambridge, Peterborough and beyond.

Ferries:

In the summer months there is a regular ferry service connecting Shotley Gate with Harwich

WHAT WILL IT COST?

Each journey is charged like a bus fare.

Concessionary passes will be valid on all daytime journeys, in accordance with standard terms of validity, special fares apply after 1900.

You will be advised of the fare when you book your journey and a ticket will be issued when you board.
