

East Suffolk Lines Community Rail Partnership
'Station to Station' Guided Walks
January – June 2012

You are invited to join a series of guided rambles from local stations exploring the east Suffolk countryside



Sat 14 Jan Westerfield Circular via Low Farm. 6.5 miles. Walk starts from Westerfield station 10.04 on the arrival of the 09.58 from Ipswich or 09.28 from Felixstowe.

Sat 3 March Brampton to Beccles 6.75 miles. ('Adrian Bell' walk.) Walk starts from Brampton station 10.17 on arrival of 09.13 from Ipswich.

Sat 14 April Saxmundham to Aldeburgh via the Sailor's Path. 9.5 miles. Return to Saxmundham by bus. Walk starts from Saxmundham station 10.00 on arrival of 09.13 from Ipswich or 09.08 from Lowestoft. Return to Saxmundham by bus.

Sat 5 May East Suffolk Travellers' Association (ESTA) AGM

Sat 2 June EARLY START Wickham Market station to Saxmundham via Framlingham. 15.5 miles. (7.75 mile option by using bus to Ipswich from Framlingham.) Walk starts from Wickham Market station 08.42 on arrival of 08.13 from Ipswich.

Sat 30 June Trimley to Felixstowe via Sheepgate Lane path across Falkenham Marshes. 9 miles. ('Deben and Coast' walk 16 in booklet.) Walk starts from Trimley station 10.18 on arrival of 09.58 from Ipswich.

These conditions apply to all walks:

- All come at own risk – no insurance cover is provided.
- Wear comfortable footwear and have waterproofs if wet.
- The leader reserves the right to cancel or re-arrange walks at short notice. Contact 01473 726649 shortly before each walk to confirm. **Train and bus times may alter; it's up to you to check beforehand.** www.traveline.info or 08457 48 49 50
- Pub or shop can't be guaranteed at lunchtime, so bring refreshments, especially on longer walks. Carry plenty of drink on all walks.
- Well-behaved dogs OK but must be on leads.
- The walks are intended to promote public transport in the rural area, so please use train or bus on at least one stage of your journey to or from starting and finishing points.
